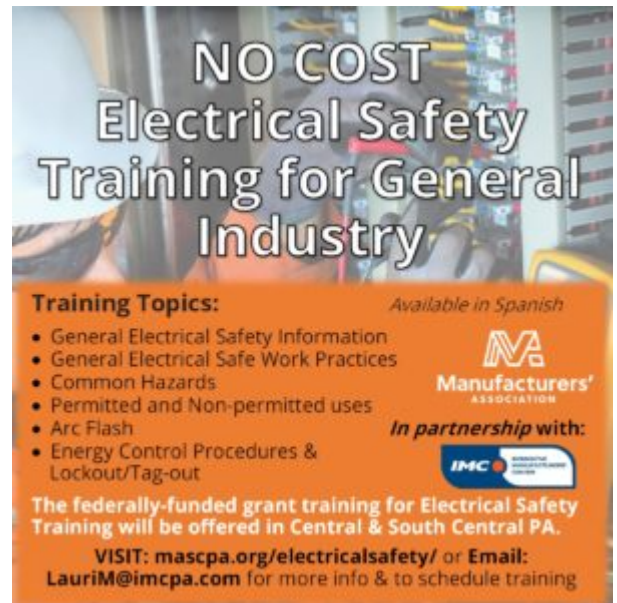


# Electrical Safety Training for General Industry
